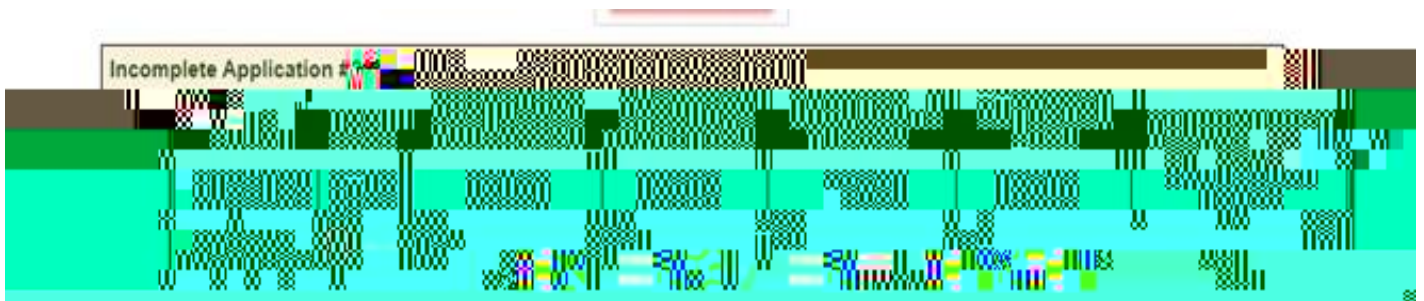

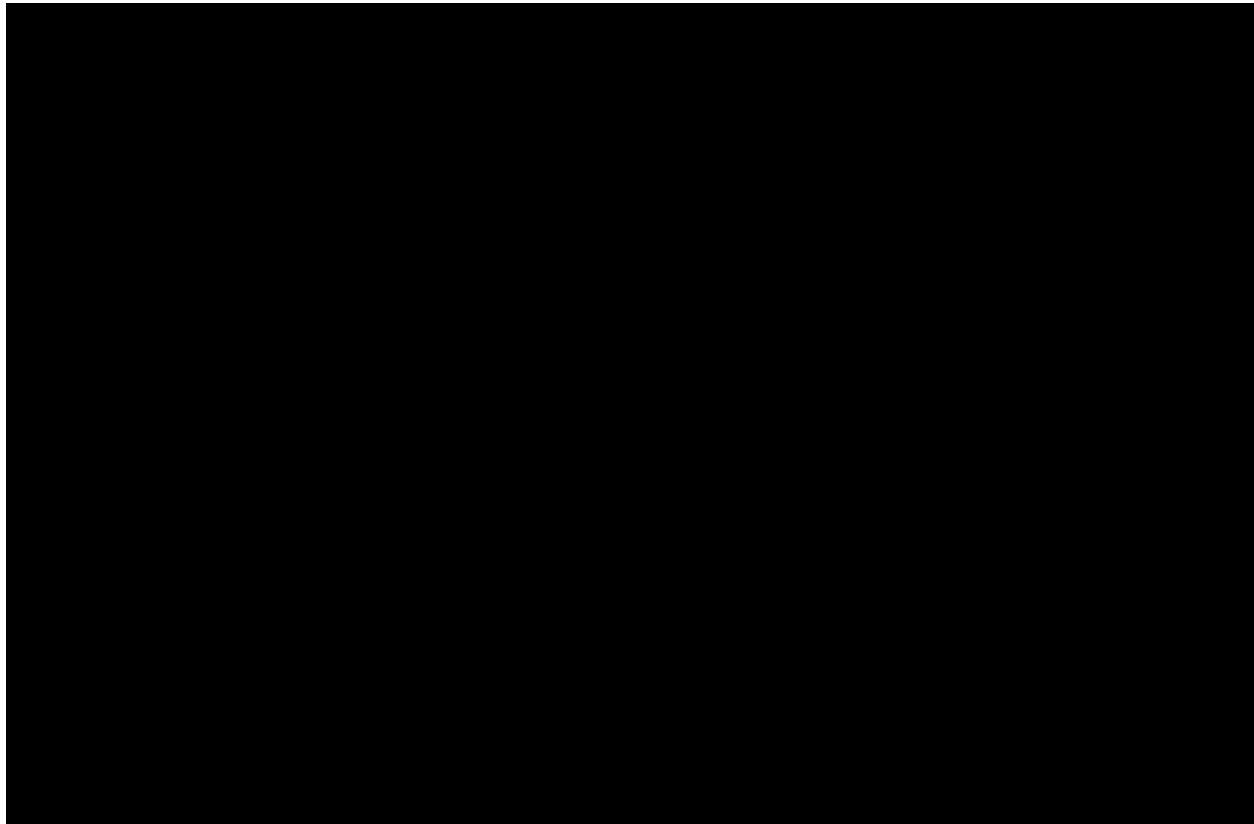

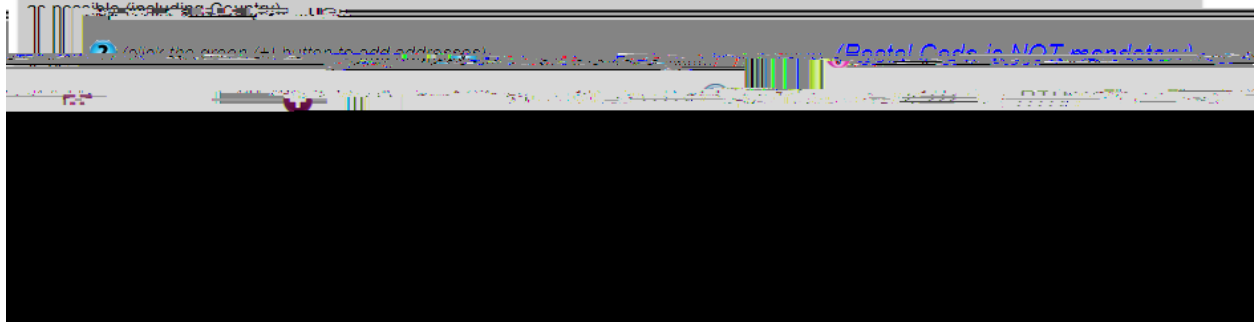

As part of the vulnerable sector application process, one of the searches we conduct involves a query of the RCMP's national criminal history database. Your information is entered into this system to help us determine if you are eligible for employment. It is important that you provide accurate information. As part of this process, you may be required to provide a copy of your identification documents and a recent photograph.

Application Process:

1. Complete the application form and provide your identification documents and a recent photograph.

2. Submit the application to the Vulnerable Sector Check Unit.

3. The unit will conduct a search of the RCMP's national criminal history database.

4. You will receive a letter indicating the results of the search.

Results:

If you are found to be a member of the vulnerable sector, you may be required to complete a Vulnerable Sector Declaration (VSD) and provide a copy of your identification documents and a recent photograph. If you are not found to be a member of the vulnerable sector, you will be eligible for employment.

Application Fee:

The application fee is \$150.00. This fee covers the cost of the search and the processing of the application.

Processing Time:

The processing time for the application is typically 4-6 weeks.

- Disclosure:** Your information may be disclosed to the RCMP and other law enforcement agencies.
- Access:** You have the right to access and correct your information.
- Complaints:** You have the right to file a complaint with the Information Access and Privacy Commissioner.
