**\*SCHOOL NAME\* SCHOOL COUNCIL**

**Filling Vacancies**

1. Vacancies of a School Council may occur if:
  - a. The number of nominations does not meet the defined number of elected members,
  - b. A member resigns,
  - c. The member who is unable to fulfill the role and resigns membership,
  - d. Other reasons.

2. The remaining members shall constitute a quorum. If a quorum is not met, the council is not maintained, and the school council shall:

- a. Ask the Election Committee to conduct an election at the next school meeting or previous election,
- b. Ask the Election Committee to submit a nomination form for the vacant position of the school council members and to obtain an election for the members of the school council to fill the vacant positions.  
*Article III: Elections Procedures.*
- c. Vacant positions, other than for a Parish or are the result of a resignation, may be filled by appointment or by a resolution of the governing body of the school community, with such a resolution for vacant positions.

3. The School Council shall meet at least once during the school year after the general election. The term of the School Council shall be until the general election.
